

Kinsey Film Has the Same Problem as Its Subject: **Fraud**



Kinsey, which is slated to open on November 12, was written and directed by Bill Condon, a homosexual activist, and financed by Myriad Pictures. MGM/United Artists backed out of distributing the film after controversy developed. Fox Searchlight Pictures is the distributor, and Liam Neeson plays Alfred C. Kinsey.

If art imitates life, then Bill Condon is the perfect director for the new movie about Alfred C. Kinsey.

Starring Liam Neeson, *Kinsey* is an airbrushed biopic of the late sex researcher who died in 1956. Even before its November 12 release, *Kinsey* stirred controversy for its adulatory view of the author of the notorious "Kinsey Reports" of the late 1940s and early 1950s.

In an interview with *Variety*, Condon described the real Kinsey as having "one brilliant but simple idea, which is still radical today – that no one person's sexuality is the same as another's and that we are all tortured by what is sexually normal."

Really? All of us? Well, Condon speaks for himself. But he makes the same mistake that Kinsey made in projecting his own demons onto his fellow citizens.

The Real Kinsey

A 1997 biography by James Jones, *Kinsey: A Public/Private Life*, revealed the Kinsey Institute founder as a sado-masochistic bisexual who worked to justify homosexuality and promiscuous sex. Kinsey's books *Sexual Behavior in the Human Male* (1948) and *Sexual Behavior in the Human Female* (1953) depended heavily on sexual deviants for data, which he interpreted as typical for all Americans.

The Kinsey studies established the false notions that 10 percent of the population is homosexual; that abortion doesn't harm women; that pornography and premarital

sex are beneficial, and that children are "sexual beings" from birth and entitled to sex with adults.

Although Kinsey aided and abetted the collection of data from pedophiles who molested hundreds of children, the film glosses over this criminal behavior.

After more than 50 years, Kinsey's cold, dead hand is still on the throttle of the sexual revolution. His disciples created sex-education credentials and founded the Sex Information and Education Council of the United States, which advocates for "child sexuality."

Kinsey is the most-cited sex researcher in court cases and law articles, and he lobbied successfully to lower penalties for sex

offenses, such as rape.

Most sex education is based on the Kinsey idea of child sexuality, which is why children are losing their innocence as early as kindergarten.

Getting Out the Truth

For years, Kinsey was hailed as a pioneer and liberator. It was not until 1990 that Dr. Judith Reisman blew the lid off with her book *Kinsey, Sex and Fraud: The*

Indoctrination of a People, co-authored with Edward Eichel.

Concerned Women for America is

working with Dr. Reisman and a consortium of pro-family groups to expose the real Alfred Kinsey. Our state-of-the-art Web page, *The Truth About Alfred Kinsey*, has easy-to-copy articles to hand out at public forums and theaters and information to use in writing letters to the editor.

While the film *Kinsey* may fool some people, it is a wonderful opportunity to re-examine Kinsey's junk science and its horrific
