I’ve just returned from speaking at pro-life conferences in Europe and meeting with Christian leaders. It gave me an appreciation for what our European friends face and how much they look to us for support.



Abortions in England are paid for by nationalized health care. Ireland still outlaws abortion, but it faces unrelenting pressure from the European Union and the U.N. to conform. And despite a decade of economic prosperity, Ireland’s families are breaking down and the renowned Irish faith is quickly slipping away.

One lovely young Polish immigrant told me she’s felt welcome in Ireland because the two countries share cultures and faith. But, she lamented, the Irish youth do not seem to share that faith. Indeed, she pointed out, 80 percent of Polish youth attend church, while only 20 percent of Irish youth do.

She asked what I did, so I told her about CWA. Moments later, she quietly responded, “What you do is so moving. How can I learn more about your organization and get involved?”

Many Europeans envy Americans’ ability to influence our nation and look to us as an example. May we be found faithful in that charge.
