

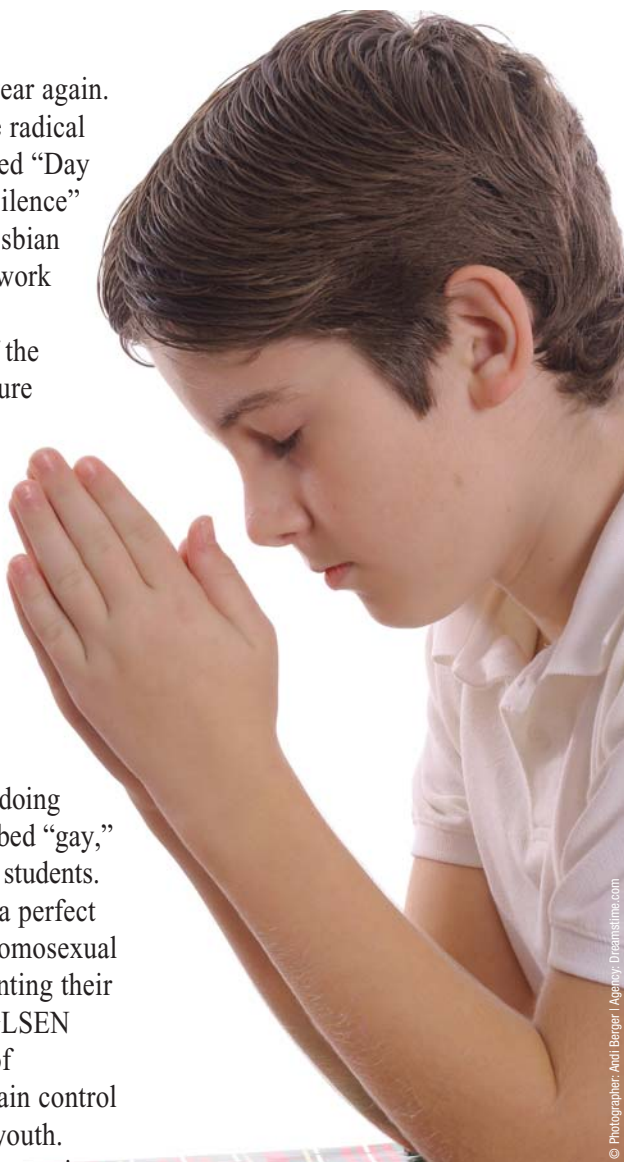
Prevailing Over Silence


