When Truth is Criminal

A Canadian pastor wrote a letter to his newspaper giving a Biblical perspective on homosexuality. He was fined \$5,000 and ordered never to write or speak on the subject again.

A tribunal in Australia found two pastors guilty of inciting hatred against Muslims for informing Christians on Islamic beliefs. They were ordered never to repeat or make similar comments anywhere in Australia or on the Internet.

On the “Day of Silence,” a protest whereby students disrupt teaching to show solidarity with homosexuals, a California school barred students from wearing t-shirts expressing opposition to homosexuality.

Concerned that the California ruling on same-sex “marriage” will be used to squash religious freedom, one lawyer said, “As gays come out of the closet, conservative religious people are put back in the sanctuary.”

Beyond tolerance and acceptance, homosexual activists and militant Muslims seek to censor moral and religious views at odds with their own.

Using speech codes, political correctness, and court orders, one viewpoint is targeted as “verboten.” It’s the one based on the teachings of the Bible.

America’s founding fathers understood the value of robust debate. They engaged in it themselves when creating our government and placed “freedom of speech” in our First Amendment.

The very speech that modern day censors seek to suppress is the one they need to hear. It’s the message of Jesus Christ, the only Way to the Father, the Truth that sets us free from sin.

Yet, if they are successful, telling the truth could become criminal.
