Back and on the Attack

The California legislature has reconvened and a number of bills threatening traditional Biblical values are up for final votes.

This is it, folks. This portion of the two-year legislative session ends on September 9. After that, all bills that passed both houses will go to the governor. Now is the time to share your opposition to these measures affecting our freedom, our families and our businesses.

AB 849 The attack on marriage continues in the legislature. AB 849, which legalizes same-sex "marriage," was placed in the Senate Appropriations Committee suspense file on August 15 and could be moved out and to the floor later this month. If it passes the full Senate, AB 849 will be returned to the Assembly for a concurrence vote on the floor.

Take action: Please call or write your state senator, assembly member and Gov. Schwarzenegger asking them to oppose AB 849.

SB 161 This bill is yet another attempt to circumvent parental guidance and support. It authorizes and encourages schools to post statements of the rights available to students without parental involvement (including medical services for pregnancy and communicable disease) on campuses and school Web sites.

Take action: Please ask your assembly member to oppose SB 161.

AB 723 Tolerance (in essence "acceptance") of homosexuality and bisexuality is not an appropriate addition to any K-12 curriculum. AB 723 requires the State Dept. of Education to integrate instruction on tolerance, including these categories, "where appropriate."

Take action: Please ask your state senator to oppose AB 723.

AB 866 Candidates must be able to share their views freely during election periods so the voters are fully informed. AB 866 limits free speech concerning sexual orientation and same-sex "marriage" during campaigns.

Take action: Please ask your state senator to oppose AB 866.

AB 1400 This bill adds sexual orientation as a "civil right" to business and real estate codes with exceptions for moral or religious convictions.

Take action: Please ask your state senator to oppose AB 1400.
