### Gay Pride Proclamation Pulled from Agenda

Last Friday, we asked you to contact your San Diego council members asking them to oppose a proclamation by lesbian Councilwoman Toni Atkins that would have commended the "Gay Pride" festivities to be held this week. Similar proclamations have reportedly been issued over the past 10 years. In fact, last year the council voted 7-0 to approve one.

*We are pleased to report that, due to the pressure from the controversy and the large turnout of San Diego residents opposing the proclamation, Atkins withdrew her resolution before a vote.*

"This is a victory for families in San Diego," said Cindy Moles, San Diego/Imperial Counties area director for Concerned Women for America. "We are grateful to our CWA members who responded to our request to pray, to contact their council members, and to attend this important meeting. They certainly helped make a difference. Common sense prevailed. We can only hope that corporate sponsors exercise similar common sense in the future and distance themselves from this immoral event."
