#### **Please Vote "Yes" on Prop 73:**

Argument: Most girls tell their parents and many who don't are abused by them.

Fact: Only 45 percent of minors report telling their parents before an abortion. Most don't want to admit they're having sex and disappoint mom or dad. Regrettably, six percent cite that they fear a violent reaction from telling their parents, or expect one (one percent). For these girls Prop 73 offers a way out of an abusive situation in these exceptional cases by allowing their doctor walk them through the legal process and alert the proper authorities to the abuse.

Argument: Girls who don't consult their parents almost always involve another adult.

Fact: When girls involve adults other than a parent in the abortion decision, 89 percent of those adults are the girls' "boyfriends." A study of 46,000 California teen pregnancies revealed that 71 percent were fathered by men who were on average five years older, and for middle school girls six to seven years older. This is statutory rape – rape in which abortionists have been complicit.

*This is why Prop 73 is so critical.* Plain and simple, it will help protect our daughters from sexual predators. Without parental notification a predator can cover his tracks and continue his abuse. Protect our daughters. Vote "yes" on Prop 73.

*Important updates:* On October 31, the president of the American College of Pediatrics wrote a letter to the president of the American Academy of Pediatrics calling for that group to acknowledge the "erroneous data" it has disseminated regarding parental involvement laws. #### **Please Vote "Yes" on Prop 75:**

Prop 75 simply requires the public employee unions to obtain written consent from their members each year before deducting political purpose dues (Collective bargaining dues are not involved.). For example, many public employee unions actively supported the same-sex "marriage" bill that passed this year, but was vetoed by the governor.
