The basics:

California's special election is November 8. To request an absentee ballot, you must send in your application no later than November 1. Click [here](#) to find your county registrar of voters' office. Some web sites have downloadable applications which can be mailed or faxed.

The issues:

Many of you joined us in helping place the "Parents' Right to Know" initiative (Prop 73) on the ballot. *Let's see it through!* Encourage your church to help pass this important parental rights initiative and protect our daughters by including a [bulletin insert](#) in your worship program next Sunday. There's *no reason* for the church to shy away from sharing the importance of supporting parental notification prior to a minor girl receiving an abortion.

In fact, understanding all the ballot initiatives is vital. The advertisements couldn't be more confusing, so please be discerning as you prepare to go to the polls. CWA has taken an official position supporting Props 73, 74 and 75. We have outlined our reasons for encouraging a "yes" vote in our election guide.
